Make your own or reinvent them!


Arrange one or both in your favourite spot! Or give them to travellers you like, so that Georgina, wherever she may be, knows that George is looking for her.



Your friend Pit will also be happy about any stork he receives.



By the way, George also likes to be a **Native American**, best of all a chief.





Or a **Chinese** asking about Georgina in his paddy field.





Or a **parrot** wishing for a good life together with a friend.





And they could be bent and crooked as well! Yes, that's perhaps even nicer!




Or a **musician** whistling a love song. And so on ...

He could be anyone!









Here, he is **waiting** for Georgina.





And wonderful.





looking for her all over the world.




